


## Post Installation on a Sloped Ramp

Residential installation only. Commercial applications may differ. Always check with local building codes prior to purchasing and installing this product.

A post can be cut to a maximum of 8° and still use a screwed on baseplate. Depending on the angle cut on the post, the head of the screw might protrude past the bottom of the baseplate and need to be ground down.

It is recommended to use TBR's instead of TBRS's for the ramp.
